Diagnosed with medulloblastoma at age 9, Yun Seo Park knew from the care she received as a child that she wanted to give back.

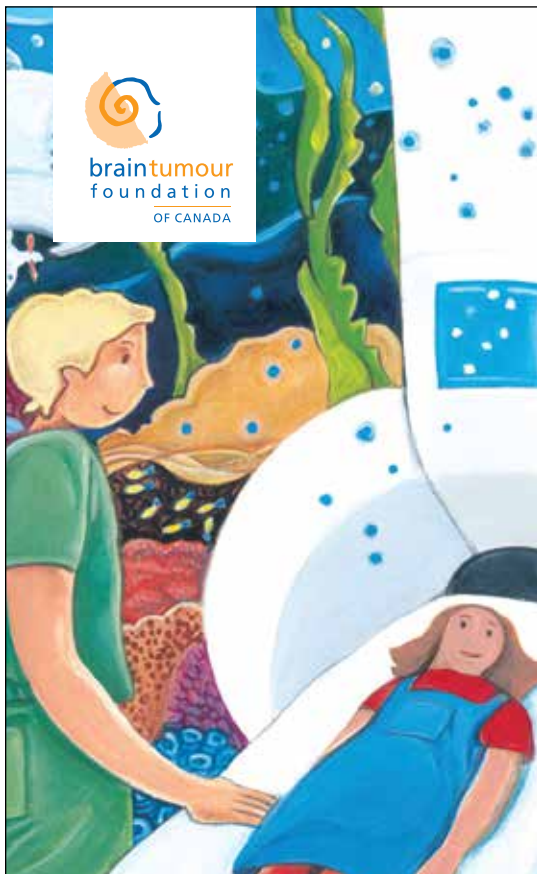
